

Lone Wolf Originals

Joe Dever is the creator and author of the bestselling Lone Wolf adventure books and novels.

Gary Chalk is the original artist who collaborated with Joe Dever on the *Lone Wolf* series. His original cover for *Flight from the Dark* was reproduced as a poster to advertise the launch of the series in 1984.

Brian Williams is best known as the artist who drew the interior illustrations for many of Joe Dever's works. However, he also painted cover artwork for a number of Dever's gamebooks and novels, including *The Sword of the Sun* novel, and the *Freeway Warrior* gamebook *California Countdown*.

Melvyn Grant is the interior illustrator of *Highway Holocaust*, and the cover artist of all four of the *Freeway Warrior* books.

Peter Andrew Jones is a prolific colour artist whose illustrations graced the covers of many of Joe Dever's works, including the novels *Eclipse of the Kai* and *The Sacrifice of Ruanon*.

Alberto del Lago is the cover artist for the Italian-language Collector's Editions of the *Lone Wolf* and *Freeway Warrior* books.

This file contains never before seen design elements of some of the Lone Wolf books. Included are scans of surviving copies of the original drawings Joe Dever made of the maps that appear at the front of the books; this artwork was then sent on to the artists involved who drew the published illustration. This includes the colour map that should have been included in *The Hunger of Sejanos*, but was never used, the map from the preceding book being reused in error by the publishers. The colour maps of Northern and Southern Magnamund date from 1979, and are the oldest maps of Magnamund in existence.

Also included is a poster advertising the release of *Flight from the Dark*, with full-colour artwork by Gary Chalk depicting the original 1984 cover for *Flight from the Dark*. The full version of a piece of Brian Williams' full-colour cover art is also contained herein (*The Sword of the Sun*); as is one of Melvyn Grant's (*California Countdown*); and two pre-release pieces of Peter Andrew Jones' full-colour cover art (*Eclipse of the Kai* and *The Sacrifice of Ruanon*) as well as the finished artwork for *Dawn of the Dragons*. Alberto del Lago has also graciously provided us with digital copies of his cover artwork for the Italian Collector's Editions of *Lone Wolf* 1–10, the cover of *Lone Wolf* 29 *The Storms of Chai*, and a new Italian edition of *Highway Holocaust*, the first two *Freeway Warrior* books.

The second half of this document is dedicated to *The Cauldron of Fear*, and documents Joe's preliminary notes and design, as well as presenting all twenty of Brian Williams' original rough sketches. Also included are a couple of pieces of correspondence between the parties involved, part of which is a (very) rough initial draft of Fred Gambino's original cover for the 1986 Beaver Books edition, complete with added notes.

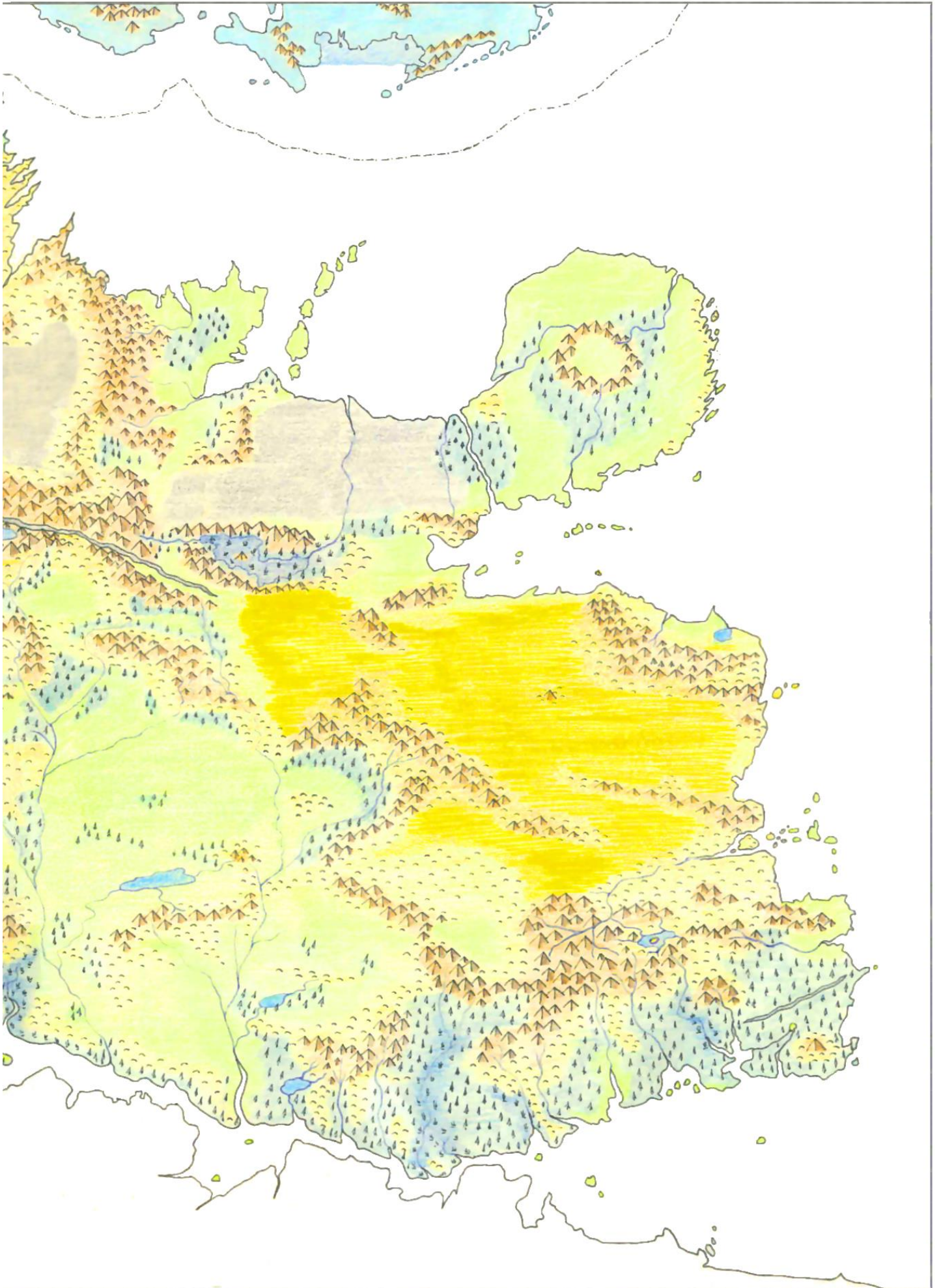

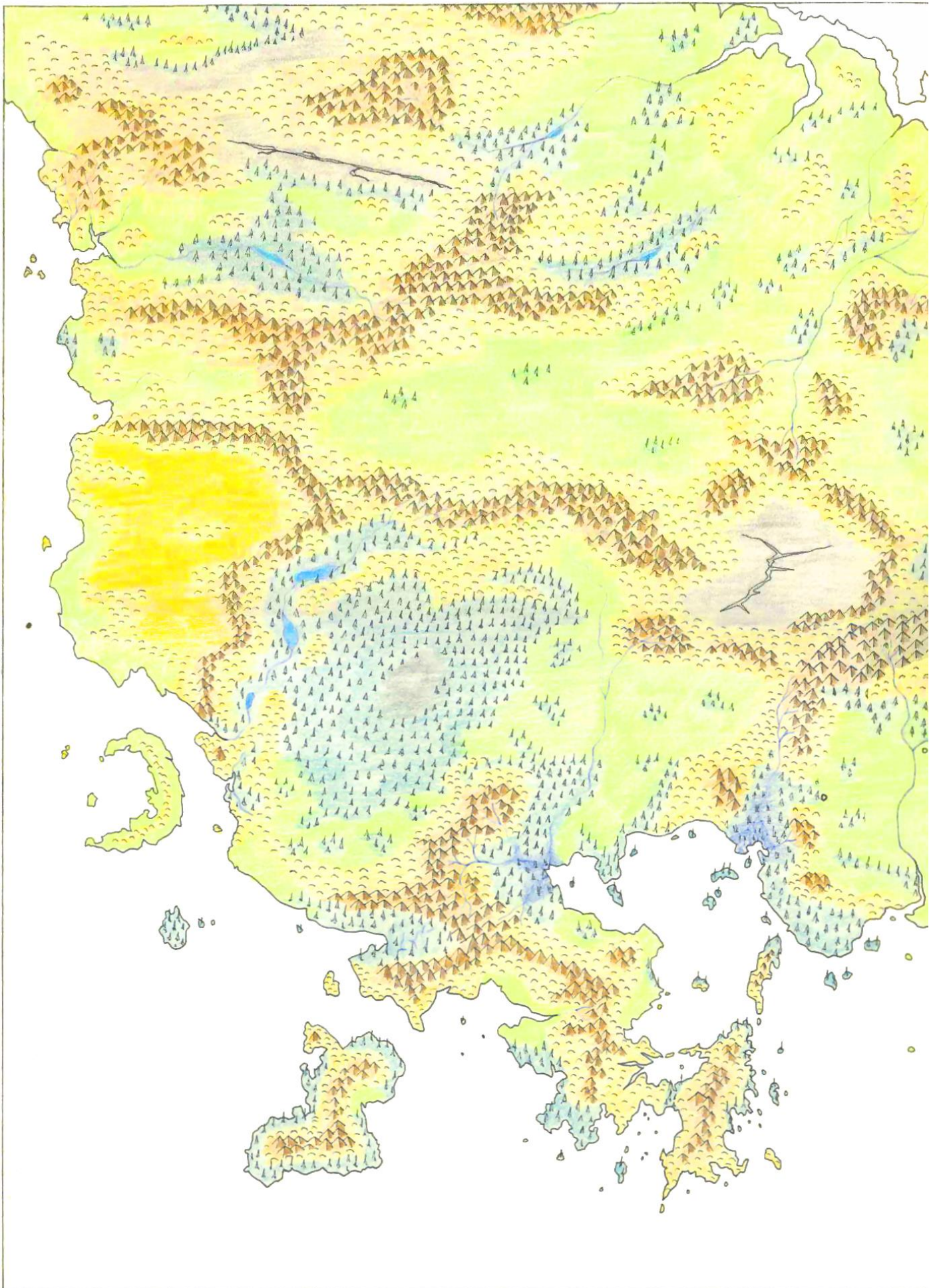

Scale in miles

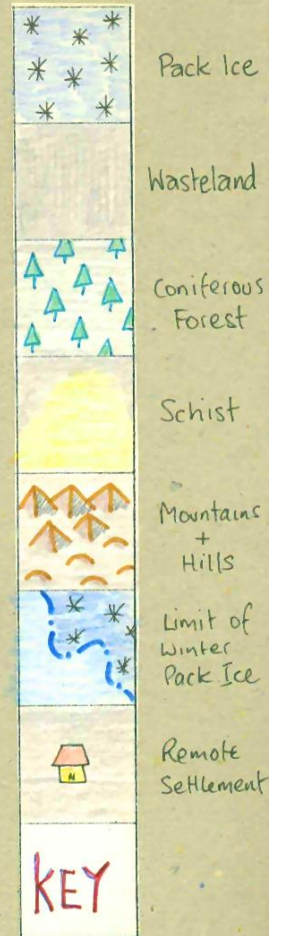


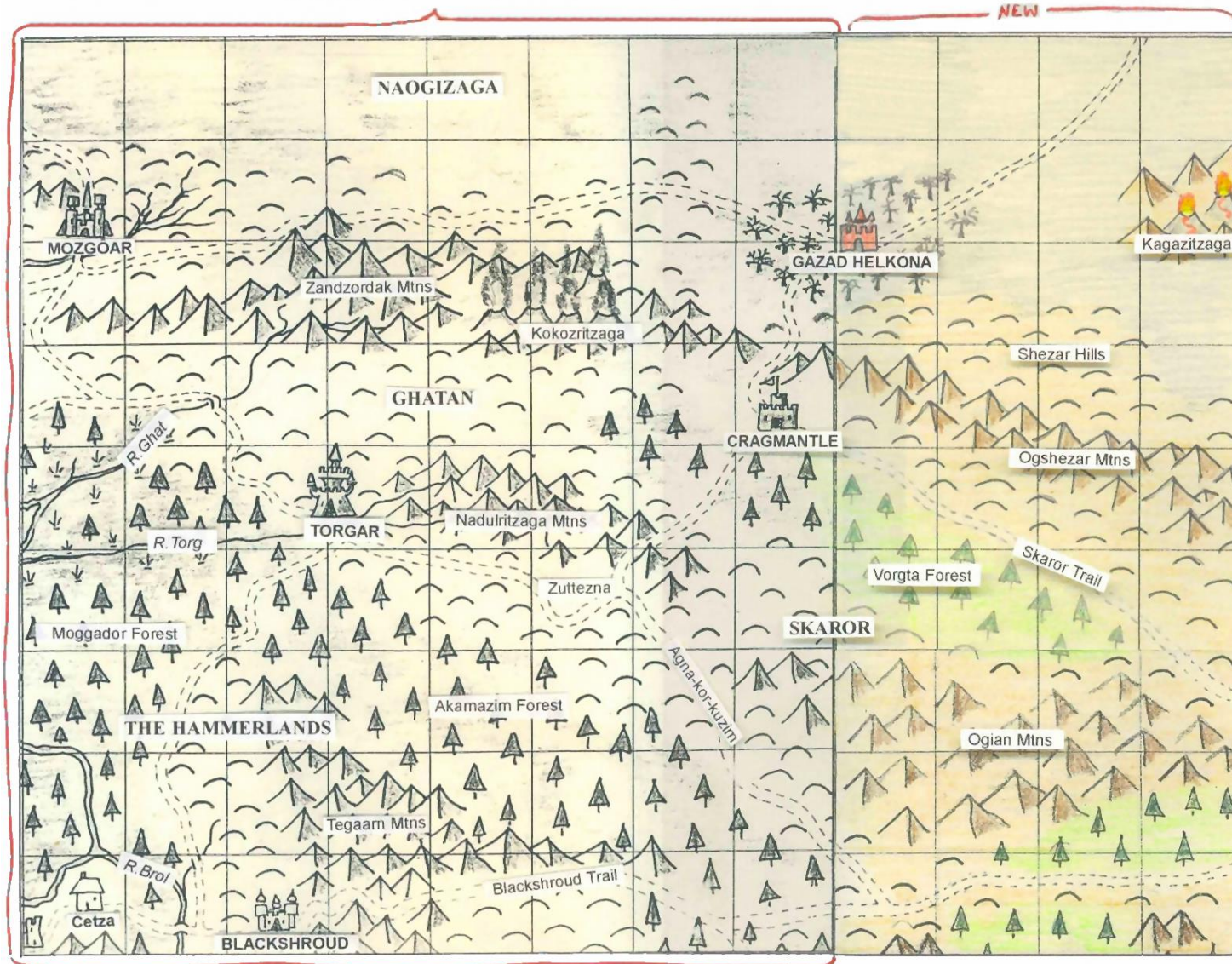

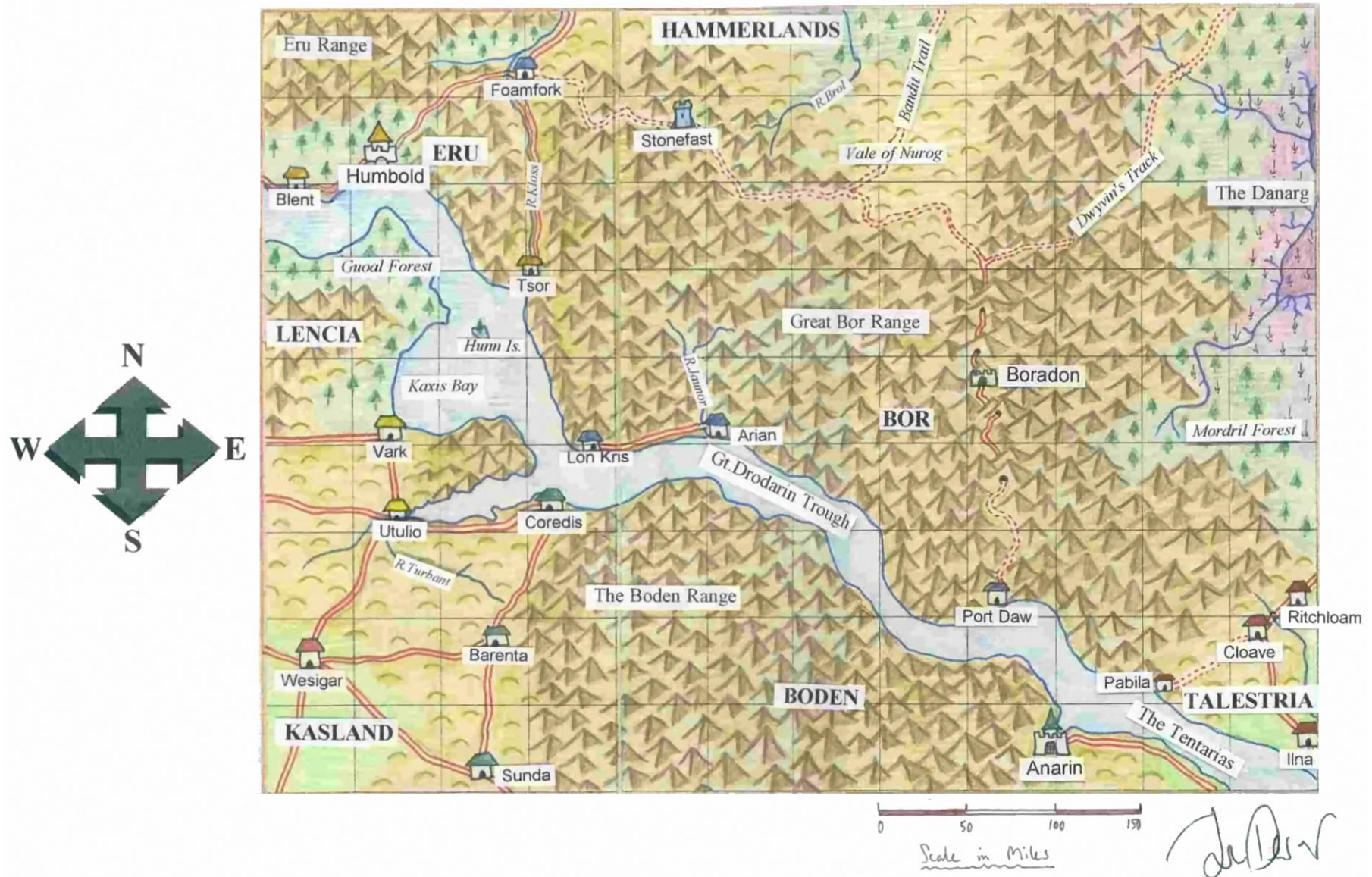

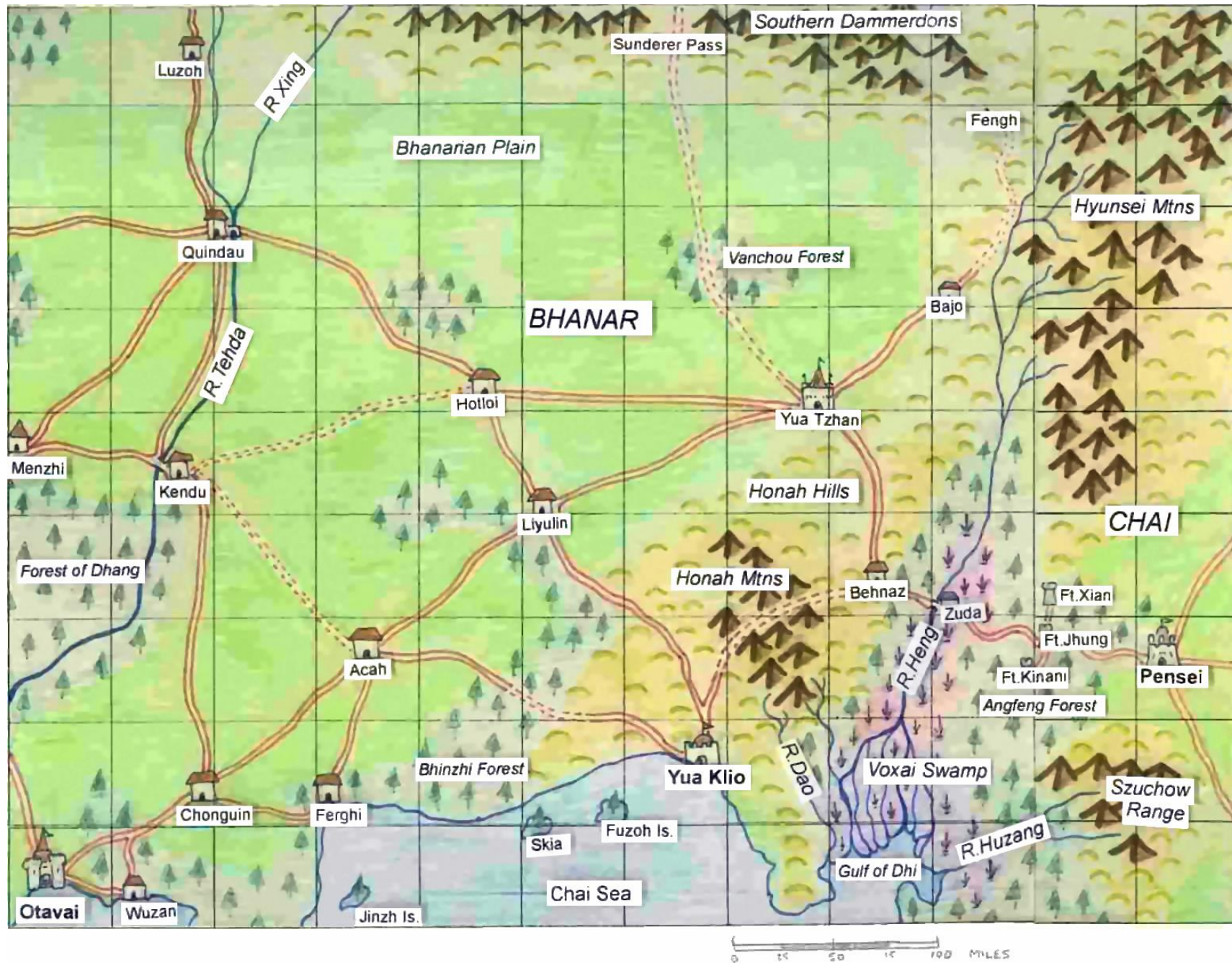

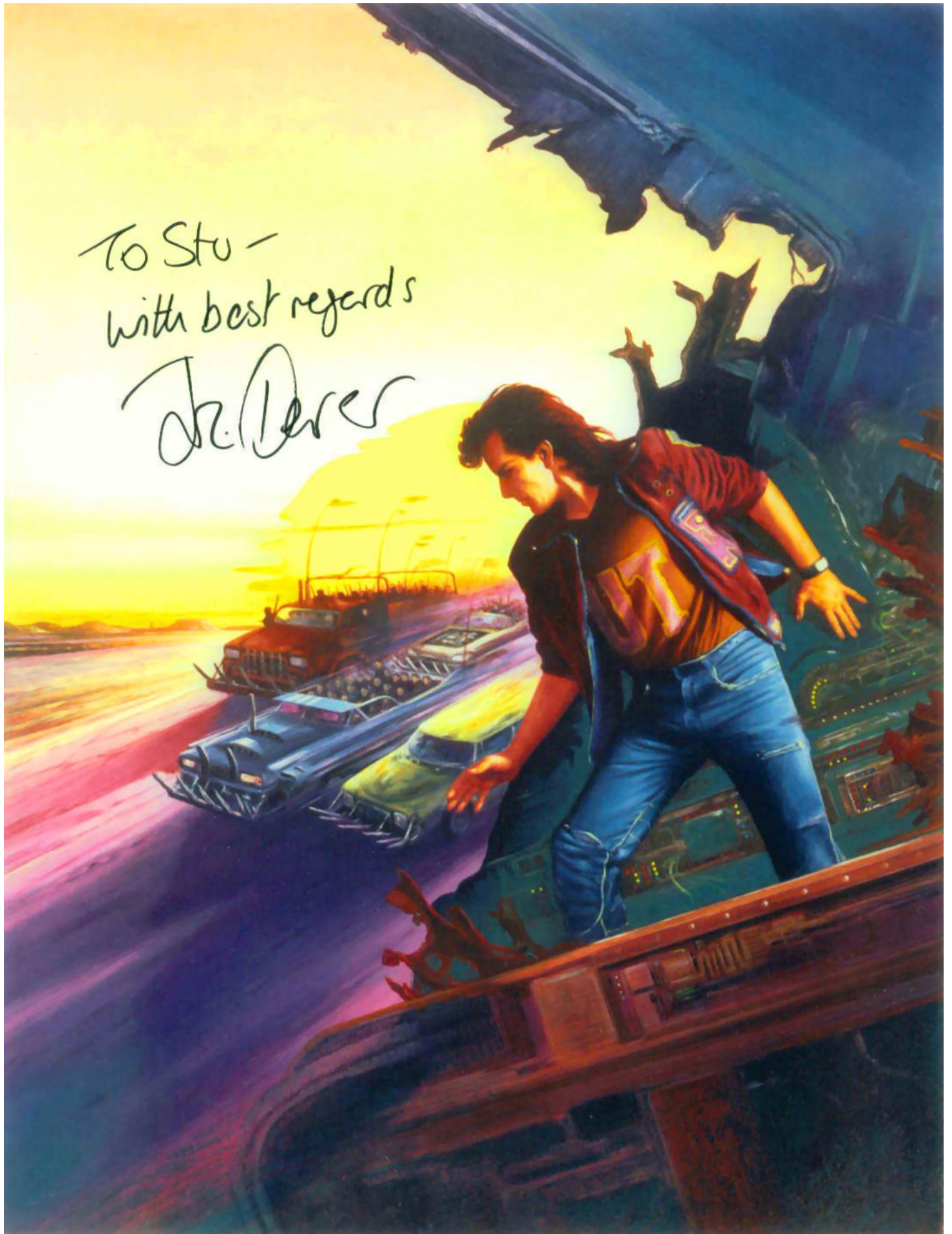

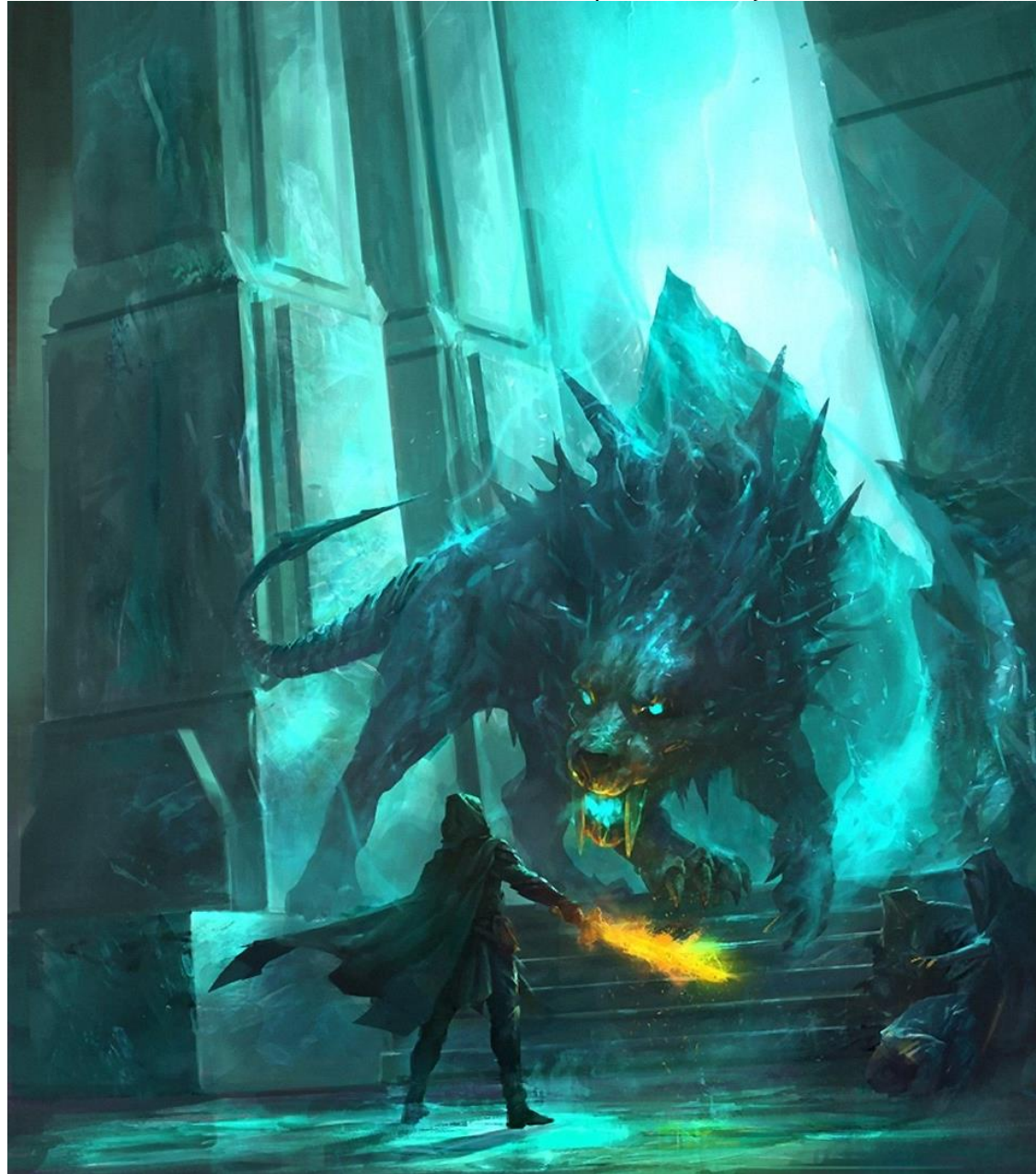

The Cauldron of Fear – From Conception to Execution

This section shows the design process that every Lone Wolf book went through, right from the initial stages of planning through to a final rough draft. Contents are as follows:

- **Story and Prompt Sheets**

These were used by Joe to determine what information would appear in *The Story so Far* . . . and *Section 1* of the book. Note that he has decided against including the background to the Tahou Cauldron, and also changed the initial profile to make the journey to Tahou more detailed (not a Levitron journey as originally planned). In the published book, Lone Wolf is accompanied on the journey to Tahou by the Brotherhood magician Banedon. Interestingly, Joe seems unhappy with his choice of President Dabudei's name!

- **Numbered Sections Checklist**

This was used by Joe to ensure that all 350 of the numbered sections were assigned for use in the book. He also notes things such as puzzle answers.

- **Disciplines/Items/Ranks checklist**

This was used by Joe to determine which important Backpack and Special Items could be brought into the adventure, and also to determine which Lore-circles and Improved Disciplines were possible by this stage in the Magnakai quest, how they could apply in the course of *The Cauldron of Fear*, and how many times.

- **Cover Brief**

This was submitted to Arrow Books by Joe Dever to explain what sort of cover design he desired for the book.

- **Arrow Books' correspondence re: Cover Brief (inc. rough draft of cover)**

Arrow Books' response to Joe's Cover Brief. The artist in question, Fred Gambino, drew several of the covers for the Beaver Books editions of the Lone Wolf gamebooks.

- **Brian Williams' correspondence**

Brian Williams' letter to Arrow Books containing the rough sketches of some of the illustrations. If you look carefully, you might be able to determine what time of year this work was being done.

- **Roughs of Illustrations I to XX**

These rough drafts comprise Brian Williams' first work on the Lone Wolf series. Note that Brian mistakenly refers to the Section 317 illustration as Section 323, which would therefore have had two full-page illustrations. For the illustration in Section 180 Joe has noted 'More Turkish' alongside the man's face. He has also noted 'More desperate' regarding the man killed by Zakhan Kimah in the illustration for Section 258.

- **Proofread Inlay Blurb**

This is included to show that even by the proofreading stage, there may still be a few *minor* errors to iron out.

Cover Brief

LONE WOLF 9 : THE CAULDRON OF FEAR

Cover Brief

The focal point of the cover should be a large medieval castle of the type depicted in Notes 1 & 2. The scale of the castle should be nearer to Note 2.

The foreground to the castle should depict a massed battle between 'good' and 'evil' forces.

The 'goods'

Traditional northern European knights and retainers of the 13th century, armed with halberds, swords, maces, bows etc. Predominant uniform colour is dark blue with yellow edging and piping. Flags and banners (and surcoat motifs) should depict an eagle (see illo.) with its claws clutching a heart. (Nb. Gold eagle/red heart)



The 'evils'

Goblinoid evil types as depicted in Note 3. Leaders should be skeletal monks dressed in red robes, on black horses and armed with staffs of black iron that shoot blue fire from their tips. Some evil human knights (black spiky armour), some orgrons (giant goblins with blue skins). Banners should be crimson and black bearing the white skull of a snake with bloodied fangs.

THE AUTHOR AND THE ILLUSTRATOR

JOE DEVER was born in 1956 at Woodford Bridge in Essex. After he left college, he became a professional musician, working in studios in Europe and America. While working in Los Angeles in 1977, he discovered a game called 'Dungeons and Dragons' and was soon an enthusiastic player. Five years later he won the Advanced Dungeons and Dragons Championships in the US, where he was the only British competitor. The Lone Wolf adventures are the culmination of many years of developing the world of Magnamund. They are printed in several languages and sold all over the world.

Joe also writes for modelling journals and is a contributing editor to ~~White Dwarf~~ Britain's leading role-playing games magazine. ~~He~~ ^{es} adapts the Lone Wolf adventures for computer play, is editor of the 'World of Lone Wolf' series and is noted for his model painting and photography.

Born in 1952, GARY CHALK grew up in rural Hertfordshire. Through an interest in history, he began playing wargames at the age of fifteen – a hobby he still enjoys today. When he first graduated from college with a BA in design, he spent three years training in a studio before becoming a teacher in art and design. He was working as a children's book illustrator when he became involved in adventure gaming, an interest which eventually led to the creation of several successful games, including 'Cry Havoc' and 'Battlecars' (co-designed with Ian Livingstone). He is perhaps best known for his artwork on the board of the successful 'Talisman' game.
